### WEST WENDOVER CITY COUNCIL MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF DECEMBER 22, 2009

The West Wendover City Council met for a special meeting on December 22, 2009. The meeting was held at the West Wendover City Hall, Council Chambers #137. Mayor Pro-tem Carter presided.

The following proceedings were had.

**1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL**

Mayor Pro-tem Carter called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. All those present and excused are noted above.
