**\*Discussion and Decision Regarding Procedure for Effluent and Culinary Water Use at Toana Vista Golf Course and Other Matters Appropriately Related Thereto**

Kerry Robinson explained that they would like to use a blend of the culinary and effluent water that is used at the golf course. Craig Neeley stated that effluent water is used at a lot of golf courses and culinary water should be used as a last resort. General discussion was had regarding the use of the sulphur burner, using all of the effluent water during the season, how much culinary to blend in and where to blend it. Leon Flinders asked if a study had been done on what is causing the quality of the course to go down. General discussion was had regarding compiling data and doing an analysis of it. Council Member E. Carter made a motion for staff to research the percentages between the effluent and culinary water for the last seven years and bring the findings back to the Council. The motion was seconded by Council Member J. Carter and passed unanimously.
