Separate sealed Bids for City of West Wendover North Gene L. Jones Way Project Phase 1 PWP No. EL 2007-231 will be received by Anna Bartlome at the City of West Wendover offices until July 2, 2007 until 3:00 PM local Mountain time and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

The project includes grading, earthwork; the installation of waterlines, sewer lines, decorative street lighting, galvanized metal railing; the construction of curb and gutter, sidewalk, ADA curb ramps, catch basins, storm drainage drop structures, concrete retaining wall, placement and rough grading of sub base for future street.
