

**NOTICE OF FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT
AND NOTICE OF INTENT TO REQUEST RELEASE OF FUNDS**

These Notices shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for activities to be undertaken by the CITY OF WEST WENDOVER.

REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about MARCH 22, 2007 the CITY OF WEST WENDOVER will submit a request to the NEVADA COMMISSION ON ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT - CDBG for the release of CDBG funds under Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, to undertake a project known as CITY OF WEST WENDOVER PEDESTRIAN SAFETY PROJECT, for the purpose of PEDESTRIAN ENHANCEMENTS, TOTALING \$350,67.75 LOCATED ON WENDOVER BOULEVARD AND RED GARTER STREET.

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

The CITY OF WEST WENDOVER has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) of 1969 is not required. Additional project information is contained in the Environmental Review Record (ERR) on file at CITY OF WEST WENDOVER, 801 ALPINE STREET, WEST WENDOVER, NEVADA 89883 CITY MANAGER, CHRIS J. MELVILLE and may be examined or copied weekdays 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group, or agency disagreeing with this determination or wishing to comment on the project may submit written comments to the CITY OF WEST WENDOVER, ATTN: CHRIS J. MELVILLE, CITY MANAGER, P.O. BOX 2825 WEST WENDOVER, NEVADA 89883. All comments received by MARCH 21, 2007 will be considered by the CITY OF WEST WENDOVER prior to submission of a request for release of funds. Comments should specify which Notice they are addressing.

RELEASE OF FUNDS

The CITY OF WEST WENDOVER certifies to NEVADA COMMISSION ON ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT – CDBG that CHRIS J. MELVILLE in his capacity as CITY MANAGER consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. NEVADA COMMISSION ON ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT – CDBG acceptance of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and allows the CITY OF WEST WENDOVER to use Program funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

NEVADA COMMISSION ON ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT – CDBG will accept objections to its release of funds and the CITY OF WEST WENDOVER's certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if it is on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the CITY OF WEST WENDOVER; (b) the CITY OF WEST WENDOVER has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR Part 58; (c) the grant recipient has incurred costs not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by NEVADA COMMISSION ON ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT – CDBG; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58) and shall be addressed to NEVADA COMMISSION ON ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT - CDBG at 108 E. PROCTOR STREET, CARSON CITY, NEVADA 89701. Potential objectors should contact NEVADA COMMISSION ON ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT - CDBG to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
